

Contact Lens Professional Fees

Our optometrists have the expertise to fit all types of contact lenses including medically necessary contacts. An annual contact lens evaluation is needed to renew your contact lens prescription. This will determine if a change is required in the fit or power of your lenses.

Contacts are an FDA regulated medical device that requires a prescription to purchase or dispense. The contact lens exam is NOT a part of a routine exam and is billed separately. A professional fee includes the evaluation of many factors that are important to the design and fit of your contact lenses. Your contact lenses need to be evaluated yearly and therefore, there will be an annual professional fee.

This fee includes:

- Initial diagnostic lenses
- Insertion and removal instruction
- Starter solutions if needed
- Instruction and review of proper care, use and handling of contacts
- Evaluation of contact lenses including fit and prescription
- Follow-up visits for up to 3 months

Professional fees vary depending on complication of lenses, prescription and level of service required.

Most insurances do not cover this and payment is expected on the day of service.
